There were 38 responses to the survey.

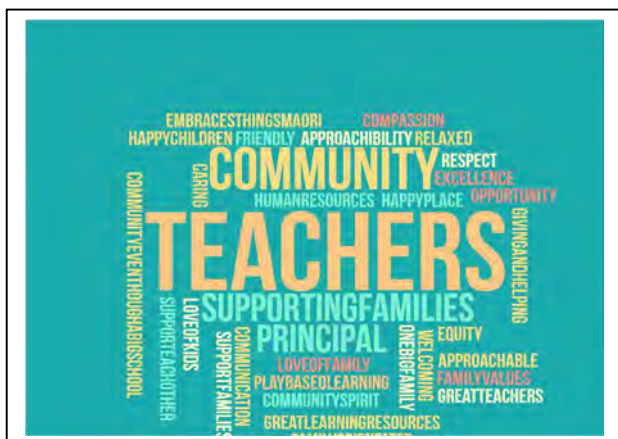
What do you like most about our school?
