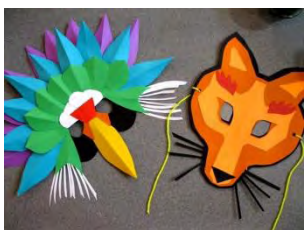
I look forward to welcoming everyone back to school for Term 4 on Monday, 15th October at 8.55am.
