ENROLMENT SCHEME FOR NAYLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL

Nayland Primary School is experiencing roll growth which is putting our accommodation capacity under pressure.

The Ministry of Education has written to the Board of Trustees requiring us to implement an enrolment scheme in accordance with Section 11H of the Education Act 1989, to avoid overcrowding at the school.

As part of this process, we need to consult with our school community, the wider community and neighbouring schools. The Board has prepared a proposed zone as a basis for consultation. That proposal is set out in the map and explanation overleaf. A larger version is available for viewing at the school office.

The introduction of an enrolment scheme will not affect children who are currently enrolled at Nayland Primary School : they will continue to be enrolled at the school. ("Currently enrolled" means that the child has turned five, is enrolled at and has started attending Nayland Primary School when the scheme becomes effective.)

For children who have not yet enrolled at Nayland Primary School when the scheme comes into effect, the enrolment scheme means that :

- If they live in the zone, they will have the right to enrol at Nayland Primary School;
- If they live outside the zone, they will only be able to enrol at Nayland Primary School if there are places available in their year group. If more children wish to enrol than there are places available, the Education Act says that places must be offered to children in the following order of priority :
 1. Siblings of current students.
 2. Siblings of former students.
 3. Children of former students.
 4. Children of staff and board members.
 5. All other students.

If more children within any one of these priority groups wish to enrol than there are places available, the Board must conduct a ballot to determine who is offered a place.

Before making any decisions on the enrolment scheme, we would like to hear the views of current and prospective parents and caregivers, and others in the community with an interest in this. Please submit all comments to office@naylandprimary.school.nz or post them to the address below or in the submissions box in the school foyer by **Monday, 12th September 2016**.

We appreciate that this process will cause uncertainty for some families and we will keep you informed as the process develops through the weekly school newsletter on our website www.naylandprimary.school.nz . Nayland Primary: From Songer Street, follow the Railway reserve to Saxton Road, north east side of Saxton Road from the Railway Reserve to Nayland Road, south east side of Nayland Road from Saxton Road to Aldinga Ave, north east side of Aldinga Ave to Tyree Drive, south East side of Tyree Drive from Aldinga Ave south end to Aldinga Ave north end, both sides of Aldinga Ave from Tyree Drive to Reeves Street, both sides of Reeves Street, south east side of Devon Street from Songer St to Langbien St, both sides of Devon Street from Langbien Street to north end, both sides of Cornwall Place to Leceister Street, follow a route through from Cornwall Place to Thetford Chase (Leceister St include 32, 30 and all sections east, Norwich St include 37, 39 and 45 and all sections east), both sides of Thetford Chase, a line to Exeter Street, include both sides of Exeter Street, Barnham Place and Rosebank Terrace, both sides Nayland Road of from Exeter Street to Whakatu Drive, south east side of Nayland Road from Whakatu Drive to Quarantine Road, south west side of Quarantine Road from Nayland Road to Waimea Road, north west side of Waimea Road / Main Road from Quarantine Road to Arapiki Road, south west side of Arapiki Road from Main Road to The Ridgeway, north west side of The Ridgeway from Arapiki Road to 148 The Ridgeway, follow the edge of Green Meadows Park from 148 The Ridgeway to 473 Main Road (north east side), north West side of Main Road from 482 Main Road to Songer Street, north east side of Songer Street from Main Road to Railway Reserve
